Definition of Nature: Nature photography depicts living, untamed animals and uncultivated plants in a natural habitat, geology and the wide diversity of natural phenomena, from insects to icebergs. Photographs of animals which are domesticated, caged or under any form of restraint, as well as photographs of cultivated plants are ineligible. Minimal evidence of humans is acceptable for nature subjects, such as barn owls or storks, adapting to an environment modified by humans, or natural forces, like hurricanes or tidal waves, reclaiming it. The original image must have been taken by the photographer, whatever photographic medium is used. Any manipulation or modification to the original images is limited to minor retouching of blemishes and must not alter the content of the original scene.

Definition of Open: any subject containing the elements of good composition and reflecting the interpretation of the photographer.

OUR THIRD PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBITION....

We have been asked to supply some prints for our third PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBITION. Dooleys Catholic Club will again exhibit our work. The exhibition will open on 1 April 2011 till the end of April.
