Our MEETING (on Friday 26th March) will be a COMPETITION NIGHT – Nature + Open. Nature photography depicts living, untamed animals and uncultivated plants in a natural habitat, geology and the wide diversity of natural phenomena, from insects to icebergs. Photographs of animals which are domesticated, caged or under any form of restraint, as well as photographs of cultivated plants are ineligible. Minimal evidence of humans is acceptable for nature subjects, such as barn owls or storks, adapting to an environment modified by humans, or natural forces, like hurricanes or tidal waves, reclaiming it. The original image must have been taken by the photographer, whatever photographic medium is used. Any manipulation or modification to the original image is limited to minor retouching of blemishes and must not alter the content of the original scene. Our judge for the evening is Richard Fackender.

I would like to draw your attention to two of our General Rules. Rule 7 and rule 13.

Rule 7 – Digitally Projected Image entries should be emailed to the Projectionist johncam@optusnet.com.au no later than two days prior to competition. Images will not be accepted on the night of competition. These need to be sent to John so they arrive no later than midnight on Wednesday prior to competition. If you are unable to attend the meeting why not download the entry form from our web site, at dooleyscc.com . The 'Entry Form' is conveniently located on the Competition Rules page at the top and also half way down the page. This form can be emailed to John Campbell along with your digital images.

Rule 13 – Any image which has not received a Merit or Credit award in a previous Competition may be re-entered twice more into any of the categories without modification. Modified entries may be re-entered into a subsequent competition only if modified to the extent they constitute an entirely different image. Changing the image from colour to monochrome and visa versa is an acceptable modification but entering the same image without modifications into small prints, large prints and DPI does not constitute an entirely different image.
