DIGITALLY PROJECTED IMAGES

RESIZING DIGITALLY PROJECTED IMAGES FOR COMPETITION USING PHOTOSHOP

Open Image in Photoshop

Select **Image** on toolbar, then arrow down to **Image Size**

Image size screen appears

Set the Resolution size to **96**

Width needs to be **1024** pixels for a landscape style image, height should be **768** or less

Height should be set to **768** pixels for a Portrait style image and the computer will set the width.

Scale Styles, Constrain Proportions and Resample Image all need to have a tick in the boxes. Click OK

Select **File**, on toolbar, **Save as** File Name: e.g. 1JohnDoe_MyImageTitle

Format: select JPEG – Click OK

JPEG Options screen appears

Tick Preview box

Using the slide make sure your image is **500 kilobytes or less**. – Click OK

Also, make sure in your email to John Campbell you indicate if your images are in Set or Open Categories.
