(Digital entries need to be sent to Ilona by **23<sup>rd</sup> September**.) Any image that has been entered throughout the competition year is eligible for this competition.

**General rule number 14. Members must have been a fully paid member for at least 6 months to be eligible for entering into Print & DPI of the Year.**
