David is to be congratulated on being granted the MAPS Honours – Master of the Australian Photographic Society – in recognition as being one of the top exhibition photographers in Australia. To receive this honour, David has attained in excess of 300 acceptances including 5 different images having won 5 awards in 5 different countries in international exhibitions. Until this year there were only two other Australians with these Honours.



The award will be presented to David at the APS Conference in Ballarat on 26<sup>th</sup> September. Currently, David is working on the GM APS (Grand Master Australian Photographic Society). It requires another 300 acceptances plus awards. He is also applying for various Honours with the PSA (Photographic Society America). This is a wonderful achievement David and we all wish you well in the future.
