## **Programme 2015**

This year, some of our members gave presentations on various topics, Photoshop tutorials, classic film cameras, what to do with photos and making pocket money from our images. ### **Competition Definitions for 2015 Set Subjects**

**Sports/Action:** an image featuring a person or people participating in some form of sporting event.

**Portraiture:** as a general rule a portrait is the likeness of a **person** or **animal**, in which the face and expression is predominant.

**Season of the Year:** the image should contain visual evidence to show any of the four seasons.

**Still Life:** a photograph of a man made arrangement of objects. The main idea is to create a good composition and objects used should be compatible with one another.

### **Macro/Close Up:**

**Urban Scene:** the dictionary defines "urban" as "of living or situated in a city or town". It may therefore be defined as a photograph showing an area of high or medium building density or an aspect of life associated with such an area.

**Human Emotions:** an image of a person or people experiencing one of the human emotions e.g. love, hate, despair, fear sorrow, joy, greed, envy etc.

**Colour Yellow:** image that depicts the colour as predominant part of subject.

**Mystery Box:** select a picture where you will include the contents of the Mystery Box. (Mystery Box will be made available when renewing your membership at the first meeting in February).
